CANAL RIGHT OF WAY

CONTEXT OF BILL AUTHORIZING PURCHASE BY STATE

Not More Than One Hundred Thousand Dollars to Be Spent in the Purchase of Right of Way to Be Given to the National Government Free of Charge—Commission Created.

Following is the entire bill, appropriating \$100,000 for the purchase of the right of way for the ship canal at The Dalles, passed by the special session of the Oregon legislature on December 22:

A BILL

For an act to create the board of commissioners of canals and locks and to authorize it to acquire and procure, by purchase, agreement or condemnation, a right of way for improving the Columbia river between the foot of The Dalles rapids and the head of Celilo Falls by means of canals and the improvement of the channel of said river and releases of damages to the United States, and to appropriate money, therefor, and to convey said right of way and releases from damages to the United States free from cost, and to declare an emergency.

Whereas, the United States, in aid of the navigation of the Columbia river, has authorized the improvement of the Columbia river between the foot of The Dalles rapids and the head of Celilo Falls, by means of canals and the improvement of the channel of said river, by an act of congress approved June 13, 1902; and

Whereas, the board of engineers authorized by said act has recommended that no work should be begun until the right of way therefor and release from damages have been conveyed to the United States free of cost; and

Whereas, the said recommendation was concurred in by the chief of engineers, and the acting secretary of war, under date of November 6, 1903, approved the said report subject to the condition that no work shall be begun until the right of way and release from damages have been conveyed to the United States free of cost; and

Whereas, the said canal will be wholly within this state, and will be of great utility and value to the people of this state and is a public use, and it will be of great public benefit to have said improvement begun and completed without delay; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

Section 1. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated out of any funds in the state treasury not otherwise appropriated, to be expended in procuring by purchase, agree-

ment, or condemnation, in the manner hereinafter provided, said right of way for said canal and improvement of the channel of the Columbia river between the foot of The Dalles rapids and the head of Celilo Falls, and releases from damages to the United States.

Sec. 2. The governor, secretary of state and state treasurer of the state of Oregon are hereby constituted a board of commissioners of canals and locks, and said board is hereby authorized to procure by purchase, agreement, or condemnation, said right of way and releases from damages, and to expend said \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary for said purposes; and to that end said board may purchase and obtain from the owners of land through which said canal will run or upon which said improvement will be made, such amount or interest in said land as may be required by the United States for said right of way, and said release from damages to the United States.

Sec. 3. If said board and any owner of any of said land cannot agree upon the price to be paid for the amount of, or interest in his said land required for said right of way, or the damages for the taking thereof, said board shall, and it is hereby authorized to institute and prosecute in any court of competent jurisdiction, in the name of the state of Oregon, any necessary or appropriate suit, action or proceeding for the condemnation of said amount of, or interest in, said land so required for said purposes, and for the assessment of the value thereof, and for the assessment of the damages for the taking thereof. And the procedure in said suit, action or proceeding shall be, as far as applicable, the procedure provided for in and by the laws of the state of Oregon for the condemnation of land or rights-of-way by public corporation or quasi-public corporations for public use or for corporate purposes.

Sec. 4.—The said board is hereby authorized and directed, as soon as all the land and interest therein required by the United States for said right of way and said releases from damages to the United States has been purchased, obtained, condemned or assessed as herein provided, to pay therefor to the several owners thereof the sums so agreed upon or assessed, and to procure the proper deeds, conveyances, and judgments, to and in favor of the state of Oregon, and releases from damages to the United States, and, for and in the name of the state of Oregon, by appropriate conveyances, deeds, releases and agreements, to convey and deliver to the United States, free of cost, the said right of way and releases from damages and all the land and interest therein, acquired as herein provided. The expenditures authorized by this act shall not, in any event, exceed the sum of \$100,000.

Sec. 5. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants upon the state treasurer in favor of the said board, upon its requisitions therefor in writing, for such sums as may be specified therein and at such times as it may require, but the aggregate of such warrants shall not exceed the said sum of \$100,000.

Sec. 6. Upon the completion of its duties herein provided for, said board shall make and file in the office of the secretary of state a full and complete report of all its actions and proceedings, which shall be and become a public record, and any part of said \$100,000 remaining unexpended shall revert to the general fund.

Sec. 7. Inasmuch as said improvement of said Columbia river may fall unless this act takes effect immediately, and said improvement of said Columbia river is of utmost and immediate importance to the people of the state of Oregon, it is hereby adjudged and declared that existing conditions are such that this act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety, and excepted from the operation and power of the referendum, and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act shall take effect immediately.

According to present plans Dr. Dowie will sail for Australia about two weeks hence, having booked passage from Vancouver.
