Following is the entire bill, appropriating \$100,000 for the purchase of the right of way for the ship canal at The Dalles, passed by the special session of the Oregon legislature on December 22:

A BILL

For an act to createe the board of commissioners of canals and locks and to authorize it to acquire and procure, by purchase, agreement or condemnation, a right of way for lmproving the Columbia river between the foot of The Dalles rapids and the head of Ceiflo Falls by means of ca-nals and the improvement of the channel or said river and releases of damages to the United States and te appropriate more, therefor, an' to convey said right of way and releasen from damages to the United States free from cost, and to declare an

Whereas, the United States, in aid the navigation of the Columbia has authorized the improve-of the Columbia river bement of the Columbia river be-tween the foot of The Dallea rapids and the head of Cellio Fulls, by means of canals and the improve-ment of the channel of said river, by in act of congress approved June 13. 1902; and.

Whereas, the board of engineers by said act has recomauthorized mended that no work should be begun until the right of way therefor and release from damages have been con-

Whereas, the said recommendation was concurred in by the chief of engineers, and the acting secretary of war, under date of November 6, 1903. approved the said report subject to the condition that no work shall be begun until the right of way and re-lease from damages have been conveyed to the United States free of cost: and.

Whereas, the said canal will be wholly within this state, and will be of great utility and value to the people of this state and is a public use, and it will be of great public beneat to have said improvement begun and completed without delay; now, there

Be it enacted by the People of the

State of Oregon:
Section 1. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby appropriated our of funds in the state treasury no otherwise appropriated, to be expended in procuring by purchase, agree

state and state treasurer of the state of Oregon are hereby constituted a board of commissioners of canals and locks, and said board is hereby au-t orized to procure by purchase, agreement, or condemnation, said right of way and releases from dam-ages, and to expend said \$100,000, or so much thereof as may be neces sary for said purposes; and to that end said board may purchase and ob-tain from the owners of land through which said canal will run or upon which said improvement will be such amount or interest said land as may be required by the United States for said right or and said release from damages to the United States

Sec. 3. If said board and any owner of any of said land cannot agree upon the price to be paid for the amount of, or interest in his said land required for said right of way, or the damages for the taking thereof, said board shall, and it is hereby authorized to institute and prosecute in any court of competent jurisdiction, in the name of the state of Oregon, any necessary or appropriate suit, action or proceeding for the condemnation of said amount of, or interest in, said land so required for said purposes, and for the assessment of the value thereof, and for the assessment of damages for the taking thereof. And the procedure in said suit, action or proceeding shad be, as far as the procedure provided applicable. for in and by ne laws of the state of Oregon for the condemnation of land or rights of way by public corporation or quasi-public corporations for public use or for corporate pur-

Sec 4 - The said hoard is hereby authorized and directed, as soon as all the land and interest therein re-quired by the United States for said right of way and said releases from damages to the United States been purchased, obtained, condemned or assessed as herein provided, to therefor to the several owners thereof the sums so agreed upon or assessed, and to procure the proper deeds, conveyances, and judgments, to and in favor of the state of Ore-gon, and releases from damages to the United States, and, for and in the name of the state of Oregon, by appropriate conveyances, deeds. leases and agreements, to convey and deliver to the United States, free of cost, the said right of way and releases from damages and all the land and interest therein, acquired as herein provided. Does the expenditures authorized by this act shall not in any event, exceed the \$100,000

Sec. 5. The secretary of state is hereby authorized and directed to draw warrants upon the state treasover in favor of the said board, upon its requisitions therefor in writing, for such sums as may be specific therein and at such times as it may require, but the aggregate of such warrants shall not exceed the said cum of \$100,000.

Sec e. Upon the completion of its duties herein provided for, said board shall make and file in the office of the secretary of state a full and complete report of all its actions and proceedings, which shall be and become a public record, and any part of said \$100,000 remaining unexpended shall Upon the completion of its evert to the general fund

Inasmuch as said improve ment of said Columbia river may fall unless this act takes effect immenately, and said improvement of said Columbia river is of atmost and imand said improvement of said mediate importance to the people the state of Oregon, it is hereby judged and declared that existing conditions are such that this act is necessary for the immediate preserva-tion of the public peace, health and safety, and excepted from the operation and power of the referendum. and an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this act shall take enect immediately
