CORN HAS GONE UP A FULL QUARTER. Standard Oil Company Reports Another Raise in the Price of Turpentine—This is a Total Raise of eight cents a Gallon in 10 Days—Results from an Attempt to Corner Supply.

VEGETABLES. Carrots, 2c per lb. Potatoes, 1c per lb. Garlic, 10c per lb. Cabbage, 3c per pound. Beets, 10 lbs. 25c. Onions, 3c per pound. Parsnips, 1 lb. 25c. Pumpkins, 15-25c. Squash, 15-25c. Celery, 10c bunch, 2 bunches 25c. Lettuce, hothouse, 5c bunch. Kraut, 10c quart, 40c gallon. Mince meat, 12 1/2c per pound. Popcorn, shelled, 3-13c cents per pound; on cob, 5c per pound.

CHICAGO, Jan. 19.—Logan & Bryan advise: The wheat market is unchanged to a shade higher. While it is a nervous market the trading operations were extremely limited. The foreign markets maintain their previous dullness and respond sparingly to any advance here.
