LAND LAW IN BRIEF

MANY INQUIRIES ABOUT
NATIONAL IRRIGATION ACT.

Leading Features Set Forth by the Reclamation Service for the Benefit of Homesteaders—No Commutation Privileges Allowed Under This Act.

Washington, Jan. 19.—Many inquiries have been received by the geological survey in relation to the making of homestead entries for lands withdrawn to be irrigated under the provisions of the reclamation act of June 17, 1902.

Questions concerning the qualifications of entrymen will be governed by the general rules relating to entries under the homestead law, except where specifically modified by the reclamation act, and inquiries concerning general qualifications should be made to the commissioner of the general land office, who has issued two circulars upon this subject, dated September 8, 1902, and October 25, 1902, copies of which can be obtained on application to that office in Washington, D. C.

The reclamation act modifies the homestead law principally in the following particulars:

1. That the secretary of the interior may, after the entry is made, require the entry to be reduced to such limit as in his opinion may be reasonably required for the support of a family. The law provides that homestead entries under the act may be limited to tracts of not less than 40 nor more than 160 acres.

2. The commutation provisions of the homestead laws shall not apply to entries made under the reclamation act.

3. The entryman will be required to pay the actual cost of furnishing the water in annual installments not exceeding \$10.

4. In making proof the entryman must show that he has reclaimed at least one-half of the total irrigable area of his entry for agricultural purposes.

5. He cannot receive patent for the lands covered by his entry until he has paid the charges for the water.

6. A failure to make any two payments when due shall render the entryman subject to cancellation with a forfeiture of all rights under the act, as well as of any money already paid.
