NEWS OF ATHENA

REV. MARTIN HAS BEEN VISITING HIS SISTER.

Mrs. Banks Passed Over From Effects of Paralysis—R. J. Boddy Dangerously Ill—Rev. Moore is Conducting a Successful Revival, Having Twenty-Nine Conversions in Three Evenings.

Athena, Jan. 23. — Rev. Dr. Martin and Rev. Brooks, pastor of the Christian church, accompanied by Miss Leota Martin and Miss Sprinkler, the great singer from Portland were visitors in this city Wednesday, where Dr. Martin delivered to a large audience a good old fashioned sermon like he did when he was here and carried on his revival meetings last spring. After his sermon and greeting to the crowd he went to see his afflicted sister, Miss Ruth McAulroy, who joined the church and was baptized during his meeting last spring.

Mrs. Dickinson's mother, Mrs. Banks, who was paralyzed last Saturday, died at the home of her daughter, Mrs. Dickson, Wednesday. Her funeral was held in the basement of the M. E. church at 10 o'clock, and she was buried today in the Athena cemetery. She leaves a husband and several children and grand children.

R. J. Boddy is reported to be dangerously ill, and is expected to live but a short time. Rev. Moore is still carrying on a big revival. It is growing more successful each day, having eight, eleven and ten conversions for the past three evenings. In all there have been 52 additions to the church during these meetings.
