IMMENSE STEAMER

SECOND OF THE TWO
LARGEST IN THE WORLD.

The Dakota and the Minnesota are identical in Size, Shape and Carrying Capacity—Belongs to the J. J. Hill Pacific Transport Combination—Is a Five Decked, Steel Hull and Six Hundred Thirty Feet Long.

New London, Conn., Feb. 6.—There was launched from the ways at the big plant of the Eastern Ship-building company today one of the largest vessels ever built in the Western hemisphere—the gigantic steamship Dakota, whose sister ship, the Minnesota, went overboard last spring.

James J. Hill and a large party of guests came up from New York by special train to attend the launching and other visitors were present from Boston, New Haven and other points. The public schools were represented by hundreds of pupils and every factory and shipyard in the vicinity suspended work for the time being in order to allow the employees an opportunity of witnessing the launching.

The Dakota and the Minnesota are identical in size and construction. When she is completed the Dakota will join her sister ship in the Pacific carrying service of the Great Northern railroad. She will be capable of making upwards of 14 knots an hour, and will be in all respects, the peer of any vessel sailing the Pacific. The ship's dimensions are: Length over all, 630 feet; width, 73 feet six inches; height to upper deck, 56 feet; to captain's bridge, 88 feet; to top of mast 177 feet. She will be rigged as a four-mast schooner with pole shafts. Though designed primarily as a freight carrier accommodations on a superb scale will be provided for several hundred passengers. The hull is constructed of steel and a double bottom extends from stem to stern.

There are five decks extending the whole length of the vessel, in addition to the orlop and boat decks. The main engines consist of two four-cylinder, quadruple expansion engines, placed abreast of each other in separate water-tight compartments.

TO TEST HARDSHIPS.

Drummers Will Organize a Stage Coach Party to Test the Difficulties of Travel.

A party of Roseburg drummers has organized for the purpose of testing the actual hardships of stage coach travel as described by the pioneer members of the fraternity, and will ride in a four-horse coach, over the mountain roads from Riddle, Oregon, to the Lewis and Clark fair at Portland, a distance of 225 miles.

The trip will be one of a purely experimental nature, and all the accompaniments of pioneer travel will be found. A coach of the old pattern has been secured for the trip, four horses will be hired for the occasion and the oldest available stage driver in Oregon will be employed to make the trip with them. The road from Riddle to Portland is thought to be representative of the pioneer stage roads of Oregon, and this trip is to be made to test the veracity of their fellow drummers who tell of the extreme hardships of pioneer travel in Oregon.
