It Exterminates the Aphis, But Must Be Used With Care to Prevent Damage to the Young Shootster Months When Trees Are Bare.

Owing to the increase of fruit pests in some parts of Idaho, the agricultural experiment station of that state is making extensive experiments in the manner of destroying the different kinds or insects and pests that are being imported into that state.

In the northern counties of the state, the apple aphis has greatly increased during the past two years, and not very many fruit districts are now free from it. Out of the many districts represented in the Idaho exhibit, at the Ogden Irrigation Congress, but one was free from the various kinds of fruit pests, and that was Mann's creek, which won the cup, hidden away in the high mountains, and separated from the other almost a day's drive.

Wherever the railroads touch and

the aphis has two distinct foods, one grain and grass the other the tree. It is claimed the aphis is actually carried from the trees to the wheat stalks and grass by ants, in the month of June, and after being nurtured on we suculent stalks , until about the middle of September, the aphis is again transported from the stalks of grass back to the trees by the ant, where they remain during the winter months, and here the eggs are laid ready to be hatched in the early spring.

The Idaho station will try winter kerosene oil, one-third kerosene and two-thirds water and one-fifth kerosene and four-fifths water. With the pure kerosene spraying fluid many shoots of the trees were killed, but no eggs hatched. With the one-

While the pure kerosene is some what dangerous to a weakly tree, it is certain death to the aphis, and Aphis Can Be Killed During Win. will penetrate to the remotest crev ice, where the eggs are deposited With a strong healthy tree, years old or over, there is no danger of injuring the tree, nor the crop of fruit, although many of the tender shoots may be retarded, and the foliage uneven. The utmost care is successfully needed to spray this, and the spraying must be done just before the buds burst out.

MOUTH OF GRAND RONDE.

to Furnish Electric Power and Light for an Immense Territory-Is Expected to Be of Immense Benefit to Lewiston-Eastern Capital Will Build It.

The Wallowa Enterprise, speaking of the plans of the Lewiston Water & Power Company to erect an enormous power plant near the mouth of the Grand Ronde river to furnish light to Lewiston, Asotin and other Snake river points, says: E. H. Libby of Lewiston,

presi dent of the Lewiston Water & Power Co., in which Charles Francis Adams and other capitalists of Boston are interested, has gone East to complete arrangements for the installation of an immense water power and electric plant near the mouth of the

It is the plan of the company to furnish electricity for lighting and power purposes in Lewiston, Asotin and many other towns in Northern Idaho and Eastern Washington and The company also has in Oregon. view the building of a street railway in Lewiston and it is generally conprime mover in the proposed building of an electric railway from Lewiston into other parts of Nez Perce county, Idaho.

Big corporations do not shout their plans from the house tops, but the people of Wallowa county and Enterprise in particular will awake some morning and recognize that that they are on the map in box car The Lewiston Water & Power company is a broad-gauged and far-seeing corporation that is identified with the particular interof the town of Lewiston.

If Lewiston prospers and becomes one of the wholesale centers and distributing points of the Northwest, the Lewiston Water & Power Co. will prosper accordingly. Hence this company in its galaxy of plans for the welfare of Lewiston has not overlooked the drawing of the entire trade of Wallowa county to that city.

And what could be more easily done when this electric power plant is established at the mouth of the Grande Ronde than to build an electric line up the Grande Ronde to the mouth of Mud creek and down Trout creek to Enterprise, completely and thoroughly tapping the entire county? Such a move would completely change the wholesale trading business of Wallowa county from Portland to San Francisco to Lewiston and Spokane, principally to Lewis-

Eastern capital is also building some large saw mills at Lewiston and who can say but what they have had their eyes on the immense body of timber on either side of the proposed route up Mud creek. the natural terminus of such a road will go ahead with leaps and bounds far beyond the expectations of the most sanguine,

Laying aside the local aspect of it, it is very evident that such a move on the part of the big Lewiston corporation soon becomes of very great moment to two large railroads sys-At present the bulk of the shipments out of and into Wallowa county are over the Harriman lines, while the building of this little line of road will throw almost the entire commerce of the county to the Hill lines, or if the O. R. & N. builds from Riparia to I ewiston it would put the two railroad systems in competition, much to the benefit of Wallowa county.
