FOR EARLIER MAIL

UNION PACIFIC ARRANGING FASTER SCHEDULES.

Three Hours to Be Clipped From the Running Time Between Chicago and Portland—Earlier Train Will Affect Portland in the Way of Mail Delivery.

"Business houses will get their mail the same afternoon it comes in if the Union Pacific train arrives promptly instead of waiting until the next morning, as is the case at present," said Postmaster F. A. Bancroft to the Oregon Daily Journal.

"The proposed change, as I understand it, is that the train will leave Chicago one hour earlier and will make up two hours or more over the present schedule between there and Huntington, and this will give us the afternoon mail at least three hours earlier than at present.

"Those delivering in the business district begin work at 7 o'clock in the morning and quit at 4, and in the residence district the day begins at 8 o'clock and ends at 5; in either case there is not enough time left in the afternoon for them to wait for the mail if it is late.

"The carriers serving the residence district have to leave the office before the time for the arrival of the mail, under the proposed schedule in order to make their afternoon rounds.

"I have not received any official notification of the change, but a railway mail clerk told me this morning that an Oregon Railroad & Navigation company official had informed him that this change would be made.

"It is customary to make a change of this nature every spring, but this year it is being made earlier than usual.

"The Union Pacific and the O. R. & N. are the roads concerned. I do not know of any others having in contemplation a change of time which will affect the arrival or delivery of mail."

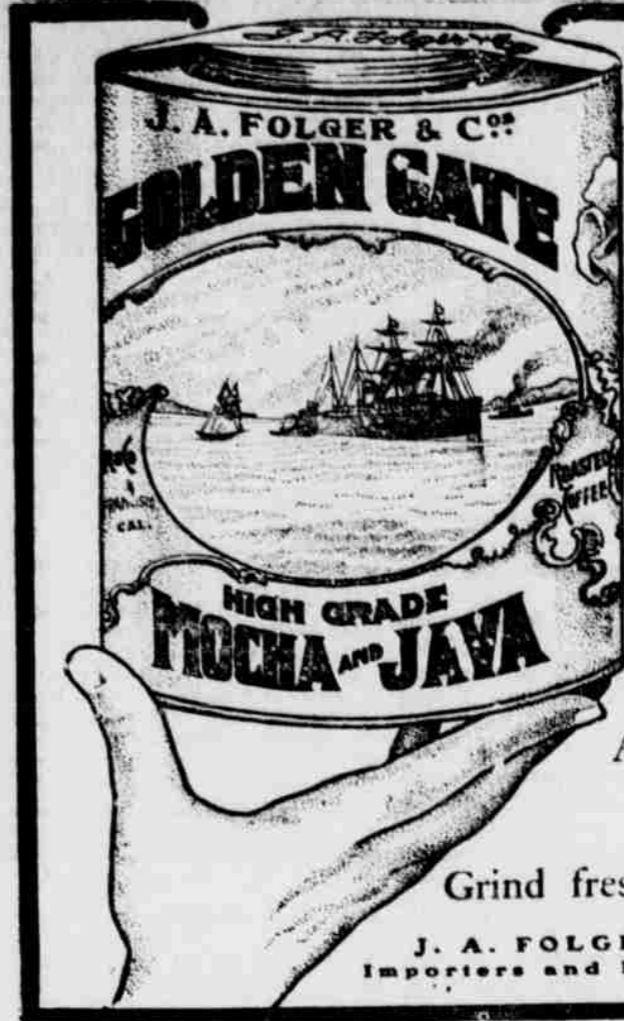

FIGHTING RANGE LIMIT LAW.

Idaho Sheepmen Will Carry Up Their Contentions to Higher Courts.

Boise, March 3.—John McMillan, president, and Montie B. Gwinn, secretary of the Woolgrowers' Association, expressed the surprise felt by the association in general and by themselves in particular at the recent decision of the supreme court of the state against the sheepmen in the two-mile limit law case of Enos C. Walling, respondent, vs. Charles Bown and L. L. Ormsby, appellants.

The sheepmen appealed from the decision of the district court of Elmore county, which awarded damages to Walling for depredations committed by sheep belonging to the appellant and grazing within two miles of the plaintiff's dwelling.

Mr. Gwinn said: "We intend to take the case to the supreme court of the United States just as fast as the legal machinery can be made to do it. The question is different from that of Sweet vs. Ballentine, decided a short time ago.

That case was one in which trespass on the land of the plaintiff was clearly shown and admitted. This latter case is one of feeding sheep within two miles of the ranch or dwelling of the plaintiff."

President McMillan said that the contention of the woolgrowers is that the two-mile limit law is in fact class legislation. It provides that sheep shall not graze within two miles of the residence of a settler while, so far as the law is concerned cattle may graze up to the very doors. The sheepmen, he said, were bitterly opposed to being discriminated against in this way.

AMERICAN LEAGUE.

Will Confer With the National League for Comparison of Dates.

New York, March 3.—American league baseball for the season of 1904 made its bow today when the magnates of the organization assembled at the Fifth Avenue hotel to discuss the schedule and other matters pertaining to the league's affairs for the coming summer. The schedule committee—composed of Comiskey of Chicago, Mack of Philadelphia, and Kellelea of Boston—has prepared its report and it will be submitted to the meeting.

No announcement has been made regarding a conference with the National league, but as nearly all of the big men of the rival organization are in the city it is possible that the two schedules will be compared before their final adoption, and mutual concessions made so as to avoid as much as possible conflicting dates in the cities where both leagues have clubs.

New O. R. & N. Engines.

The Oregon Short Line has just received 16 new passenger engines of the Atlantic type, one of the most improved classes of engines built. They are simple engines, with high wheels and are designed to make up time on fast schedules. Four of them run into Huntington. The O. R. & N. will probably get a new supply of passenger engines in the near future, for the Umatilla-Huntington divisions. The new compound freight engines have now been in service just a year and are giving the best of satisfaction.
