### WILL LECTURE ON THE BOERS.

Gen. G. D. Joubert and Captain O'Donnell at the Frazer Monday Night.

The Daily Express of Duluth, Minnesota, says of General Joubert, who gives an illustrated lecture on the Boers at the Frazer Monday night:

"Gen. G. D. Joubert and Capt. W. S. O'Donnell, two celebrated leaders of the Boer army in the recent war with England, have been in Duluth, guests at the St. Louis, during the past week. During their stay in Duluth they mingled among the people, always receiving assurances of universal sympathy with the people and the cause, of whom they are the noble representatives. The cordial reception given them here, by the way, is not an exception. They speak in grateful terms of the hospitality shown them by the American people. Representing as they do a lost cause and a discouraged people, they are the more appreciative of the kindly public interest shown everywhere.

"They lecture at the Lyceum Sunday night on the Boer war and Boer history.

"In closing Captain O'Donnell said: 'America served breakfast to England in 1777. In 1812 you gave them a red-hot dinner, and I believe you can serve their supper whenever you wish. I could not reside in South Africa under the present conditions and I have come to America. I am proud to say that I have made application to become a citizen of the United States.'

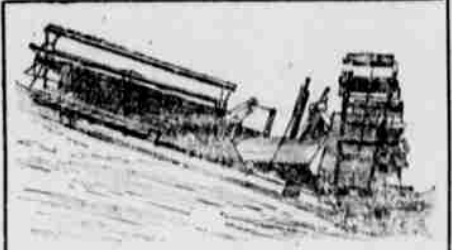
