EXPERIMENT FARM

AGRICULTURAL DEPARTMENT LOCATES IN CALIFORNIA.

Choice Tract of Land Selected by United States Government on Which Will Be Located Largest Agricultural Experiment Station in the World—Climate of Northern California Adapted to Every Known Variety of Farm Products.

Sacramento, Cal., April 8. — The United States department of agriculture has decided to establish a plant introduction garden and experiment station at Chico, California. Contracts for the necessary land have been closed and work has begun on what will undoubtedly be the greatest institution of its kind in America and perhaps in the world.

A beginning will be made with 90 acres, but it is the intention of the department to extend the area as the needs of the institution require. The garden will be devoted to experimental culture of the plants introduced from various parts of the world and a careful study of plant life.

Such an institution has long been contemplated by the Agricultural department. California was selected for its location on account of climatic conditions which admit of the culture of tender plants from the tropics and of northern products as well.

The ideal location for such an institution is that which admits of the successful cultivation of the widest possible range of products, and the commission entrusted with the duty of selecting the site believe they have found it at Chico.

This commission was composed of Prof. P. H. Dorsett, government expert, who will have charge of the institution, and Prof. A. V. Stubenrauch, of the University of California.

They spent months in making a careful study of conditions affecting plant life in various portions of the state, visiting and carefully inspecting each locality likely to prove available. The decision in favor of Chico was reached sometime ago, but the site selected could not be secured and another tract had to be chosen, which has now been done and the purchase consummated.

Chico is situated near the eastern border of the great Sacramento valley, 75 miles north of Sacramento, the state capital, and was the most northerly point considered by the commission.

Climatic conditions in California are affected but little if at all, by conditions of latitude. The orange, the lemon and the olive being staple products of a district that measures fully 500 miles north and south.

PILGRIMAGE,

Bishops, Priests and Laymen Off to Holy Land.

London, April 8.—A pilgrimage to the Holy Land headed by the Bishop of Shrewsbury and the Bishop of Waterford, and including over 50 priests and several hundred laymen, will leave England next week. The pilgrimage is claimed to be the first of modern times under exclusively Roman Catholic auspices.

A service will be held in Westminster Cathedral Monday, the day prior to the departure of the pilgrims, when Archbishop Bourne will solemnly bless the pilgrimage flag which will be taken by the pilgrims to the Holy Land. The journey is expected to occupy about six weeks.

STREET RAILWAYS

CHICAGO HAS VOTED FOR MUNICIPAL OWNERSHIP.

Great Victory for the State Socialists —Of Thirty-Five Councilmen the Republicans Have a Majority of One—Vote Was Four to One for City Ownership, and Two and a Half to One to Put it into Execution at Once.

Chicago, April 8.—In the municipal election today the republicans elected 18 aldermen, the democrats 16 and one independent republican who repudiated the "machine" in the Sixth ward was chosen a member of the council.

The next council will be formed of 36 republicans, 31 democrats, 2 independents, one of whom is a democrat and the other a republican and one socialist.

The chief interest in the election, however, centered in the vote on the proposed municipal ownership of the street railways. In this connection what is known as the "Mueller law" passed by the last state legislature was submitted to the people. The law authorizes cities in Illinois to construct, own, operate and lease street railways and to provide the means therefor.

On this proposition the vote stood 152,434 for the proposition and 30,104 against; on the proposition that the city should at once take over the street railways into its control the vote stood 120,744 for, 80,893 against.

The question of electing members to the board of education by direct vote of the people was also decided favorably.
