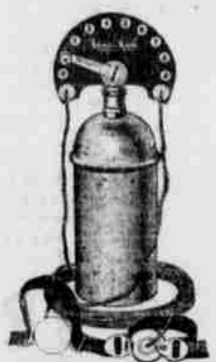

REGISTRATION IS VERY

LAGGARD AND IRREGULAR.

Prospects That Many Who Will Be Otherwise Legally Qualified Will Be Shut Out From the Right of Franchise—Registration Clerk Kennedy Will From Now On Keep the Books Open Evenings.

The registration books show about 2750 names at the present time. The voters are registering, but it is slow work, and unless they hurry there will be a large number shut out at the election the first of the coming month and at the presidential election in November.

In 1902 there were 4525 men in this county who registered, and at the election about 500 men in the county had to swear their votes in order to save their franchise.

During the last days of the registration, and at present, Clerk Kennedy will be willing to be at the office in the evening to accommodate those who have not time to register during the day. The plan of keeping the office open was tried two years ago, but it was found that the people did not appreciate the convenience and would not come to the office when it was open evenings. It will be the plan, therefore, to register anyone whenever he has time to go to the office, but no regular evening hours will be observed, for a time at least.
