SUGAR BEET CROP

OUTPUT FOR 1904 WILL REACH 300,000 TONS.

Fifty-Six Factories Now Operating in the United States—Seven New Factories Being Built This Year—United States Imported 4,216,108,106 Pounds of Sugar in 1903—Per Capita Consumption Over 71 Pounds.

The Sugar Beet Gazette of May the 5th of Chicago, gives a list of 53 sugar factories in the United States that are preparing to operate this sugar campaign. When all these get to work they will slice, squeeze and extract the sugar from 36,700 tons of beets daily.

In addition to the factories in operation there is the one at Watsonville, Cal., of 1000 tons daily capacity not in operation, and seven factories being constructed that expect to be ready to help slice up the crop of 1904, these have a capacity of 4000 tons.

If the new factories all get to running and those now ready meet with no accident, there will be worked up each day of the sugar beet campaign of 1904, 40,700 tons of beets. Our readers can form some idea of the amount of work this means, and money paid to farmers by considering what our factory does.

In 1900 there were 30 sugar beet factories in the United States with an invested capital of \$23,141,719, giving employment to 1907 wage earners in the factories, exclusive of officials and clerks, to whom were paid that year \$1,097,297 as wages. These factories in 1900 paid for material used therein, \$4,893,796 and produced \$7,323,857 worth of salable product, of which \$7,222,581 was for sugar; \$25,102 for molasses and \$76,174 for pulp and other product.

In 1903 there were imported into the United States 4,216,108,106 pounds of sugar valued at \$72,008,973. The average cost of sugar in foreign countries in 1903 was 1 cent 7.1 mills per pound, and the wholesale price in New York was 4.64 cents per pound. The per capita consumption of sugar in the United States in 1903 was 71.1 pounds.

The growth of the sugar beet industry in the United States as indicated by the annual product is as follows: In 1877 the first in which sugar from beets found a place on the record, there were 446 tons made in the United States out of a total of 138,500 tons of sugar produced in the United States.

In 1878 the production of sugar from beets fell to 223 tons; in 1879 it began to rally and the tonnage was 257, the next year it was the same. For seven years the industry struggled for existence with the prospect of utter failure, falling in 1887 to 255 tons.

But in 1888 the product passed the thousand-ton mark with 1640 tons; the next year the 2000-mark was passed with 2800 tons, with some fluctuations the 100,000-ton mark was cleared in 1901 with 125,859 tons, and in 1903 247,563 tons of sugar were made in the United States from beets. It now looks like the 300,000 mark will be passed in 1904.

majority in this county, hence we must select our very best men to put up for office. I believe I can truly say that no one, republican or democrat, can justly claim that he could tell my politics by my conduct in office. I realize that I am a servant of all the people.
