SATOLLI IS COMING

BEARS AN IMPORTANT

MESSAGE FROM VATICAN.

Some Relations Between the Mother Church and the American Branch Are to Be Reconciled-The Latter Has a Tendency to Break Away From Absolutism-Shall the Gregorian Chant Be Established? and Shall Women Be Eliminated From Church Choirs?

Washington, D. C., May 27.—Though they decline to discuss the matter publicly, it is known that the Catholic church leaders in Washington and elsewhere throughout the country are indulging in much speculation just now as to the real purpose of Cardinal Satolli's visit to the United States. His eminence is scheduled to sail from Naples today and it is undertood that upon his arrival in New York he will proceed direct to this city. Several stories are current as to the object of the cardinal's visit, but all of these are palpably more in the nature of excuses than reasons. It is not believed in well-informed cirthat he is coming solely to visit the St. Louis exposition, nor is it regarded as likely that the purpose of his trip is to officiate at the Maloney vedding, as announced in a recent Philadelphia dispatch.

More reasonable is the story that appeared in a recent issue of the Fi-garo of Paris, which declared that he real purpose of Satolli's visit was o institute an inquiry into the pres condition of Roman Catholicism in the United States and to investi-gate serious difficulties said to have arisen between the Apostolic Delegate Falconio and a majority of the Ameri an bishops.

"The American eniscopate." ording to the writer in the Figure. is resolved to enjoy certain liberty and finds it difficult to submit to the absolutism of Rome, which would im-pose regulations cutirely at variance with American customs. The turn From Pendleton to Chicago and rethings are taking arouses a certain amount of anxiety at the Vatican,

Chief among the ferred to and regarded as entirely at variance with American customs is the papal letter issued about a year ago calling for the re-establishment of the Gregorian chant in all of the Ro-man Catholic churches and the elimifrom date of sale; final return limit nation of women singers from the 90 days from date of sale. choirs. Subsequent to the issuing of this order a meeting of the archbishops of the country was held in this city to consider the matter. At the close of the session Archbishop Messmer of Milwaukee, was quoted as having said that there would be no changes in the music of the American Catholic churches for the present. for it was the opinion of all of the archbishops that under the present circumstances it would be practically impossible to enforce the decree.

Cardinal Gibbons was asked to write to the Vatican of the facts which led to this decision, and to ask for advice and a modification of the decree, which would make its enforce-ment possible. The archbishops then decided to do nothing more in the matter until a reply should be received from Rome. At the same time there appears to be some dissension among the American bishops, all of them not holding out for the decision of the Washington conference but, on the other hand, appearing to favor the literal enforcement of the decree from Rome. Thus, within the last few weeks, Bishop Keiley has eliminated women from the choirs of his diocese, and a tentative step in the same direction has been made by Archbishop Farley in regard to the choir of St. Patrick's cathedral New York city.
