## RECLAIMING IDAHO

MINUTE DESCRIPTION OF  
THE MINADOKA PROJECT.

Government Will Expend \$2,600,000  
in Reclaiming Desert in the Snake  
River Basin—Immense Masonry  
Dams Will Be Constructed to Form  
Base for Pumping Plant to Throw  
Millions of Gallons of Water Per  
Day.

A special from Washington gives a  
minute description of the Minadoka  
government irrigation project in Idaho  
as follows:

At an expenditure of \$2,600,000,  
which has been set aside for the construction of great impounding dams and diversion canals above the Minadoka rapids, fully \$12,000,000 in taxable property will be created in this basin.

Taking as a basis the last census agricultural figures for Idaho the 120,000 acres to be reclaimed under the project will, when settled under irrigation, represent the latter value, while the whole earnings of the land will amount to about \$2,000,000.

With this area cut up into 1400 farms, as is proposed by the government a rural population will be created of 7000 which will bring with it an urban population of probably another 7000 or 14,000 people.

It is possible to divert about 3000 cubic feet of water per second for use on the land, and by turning it back into the river to generate 17,000 horse power, which can be used for pumping and to supply water to irrigate about 53,000 acres of land lying above gravity canals.

The dimensions of the dam to be constructed will be 50 feet in height and 575 feet in length. It will be of solid masonry, which will be immovable as the canyon walls, of which it will become a part. The canal on the north side of the river will be cut through solid rock for a distance of one mile.

It will be 67 feet wide and 10 feet deep. At the lower end on this section will be located a power station, where the 3000 second feet of water will fall 50 feet, developing 17,000 horse power.

One thousand of this 3000 second feet will have an additional fall of 20 feet, which will develop 2000 horse power more, and this power, if not needed for pumping, can be utilized for electric lighting, electric railways, mining, manufacturing, etc.

The cost of the pumping plant is based on the proposed installment of 15 huge pumps, having a capacity each of about 110 second feet.

A second-foot is a cubic foot of water passing a given point each second, and is equivalent to a flow of 448 gallons a minute, so that each of these 15 pumps will throw about 50,000 gallons a minute.

Horse Thieves Plentiful.

That horse thieves are boldly operating in this country in open defiance of the authorities has been apparent for some time, and farmers in the northern end of the county have been losing valuable animals right along. Whether the horses are taken from the pasture and taken to the mountains or are taken across the Snake river is not known, but apparently the Texas method of treating horse thieves will have to be resorted to, to stop the business. Mr. L. Cyrus, of Covello, is out with a reward of \$25 for the recovery of three valuable animals which were doubtless stolen, and continual rumors of stolen horses are heard nearly every week.—Dayton Courier-Press.
