## DIEHL IS APPOINTED

NOW JUDGE ADVOCATE GENERAL OF THE NAVY.

His Selection a Surprise, as His Name Had Not Been Mentioned for the Position—Is a Man of Tact, Judgment and Presumably All the Other Qualifications—Has a Reputation for Professional Learning and as a Diplomat.

Washington, D. C., June 2.—As a reward for the capable manner in which he represented the United States with the gunboat Marietta at La Guayra while the warships of England, Germany and Italy were blockading and bombarding the Venezuelan coast in December, 1902, Commander S. W. B. Diehl becomes judge advocate general of the navy in succession to Captain S. C. Lemly, whose term in that important position expired today.

The selection of Commander Diehl was somewhat of a surprise to naval circles as his name had never been mentioned in connection with the place. He had more of a reputation as an all round capable officer, with a specialty for compass work, than as a lawyer, he is the author of a standard work on the deviation of the compass needle.

During the Venezuelan imbroglio the little Marietta was the only American warship in Venezuelan waters, although Admiral Dewey, with an immense fleet, was not far away, at Culebra, Porto Rico. It looked for a time as if the aggressive tactics of the allies would render a show of force by the United States necessary. Commander Diehl won the confidence of the foreign commanders, although they were his seniors, and the navy department was convinced that his tact had much to do with keeping the United States safely out of the international complication.

Commander Diehl is of German descent and throughout his naval career which began when he was appointed to the naval academy in 1869 from Pennsylvania, he has been credited with cool judgment and great ability. He was assigned to duty in Washington in 1887 as superintendent of compasses and remained until 1889. He again performed that duty in 1897 and 1898. Having served in the meantime on the Detroit, the Machias and the Cincinnati, he was engaged in special service on the Buffalo during the Spanish-American war, and after the war he returned to Washington, again as superintendent of compasses. Captain Lemly, the retiring judge advocate general, was at the naval academy at the same time as Commander Diehl. He was born in North

Carolina and was appointed to the academy from that state. He served on the Atlantic station from 1872 to 1876, on the Essex from 1876 to 1879, on the Palos from 1881 to 1883, and subsequently on the European station. He was appointed judge advocate general of the navy 12 years ago. As judge advocate of the Schley court of inquiry Captain Lemly was much criticised by adherents of Rear Admiral Schley and was caricatured from one end of the country to the other, but his conduct of the case was regarded by the authorities as of a high order of excellence.

## COBDEN CENTENARY.

Celebration of Celebrated Free Trader's Birthday.

London, June 3.—With the entire country lined up in support of or in opposition to the Chamberlain tariff scheme it is not to be wondered that popular interest is being manifested in the centenary celebrations of the birth of Richard Cobden, the great apostle of free trade. The anniversary is being celebrated in many parts of the country. In addition to the great Alexandra Palace meeting tomorrow, where John Morley and Sir Henry Campbell-Bannerman will be the principal speakers, and the Birmingham gathering on the same day, meetings will be held in Edinburgh, Rochdale, Bradford and other Scottish and English towns. At Cobden's birthplace, Midhurst, a demonstration for the whole of the county of Sussex took place today at Oatcroft, a portion of the old estate which was purchased as the nation's tribute to Cobden.

Richard Cobden, one of the foremost of English politicians of the last century, was born at Midhurst in 1804. In 1824-35 he traveled extensively in Turkey, Greece and Egypt, and also visited the United States. The result of his travels appeared in several pamphlets in which he ridiculed the pretensions of diplomacy, and asserted England's mission to be the avoidance of war and the extension of commerce. To his lectures all over the country, and his speeches in parliament, (to which he was returned in 1841), were in great part due the abolition of the corn laws at so early a period as 1846.
