The Local Option press committee has issued the following reply to the circular of the Liquor Dealers' Association...

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received at the office of the county treasurer of Umatilla county, Oregon, at Pendleton, Oregon on or before Wednesday, the 15th day of June, at five o'clock p. m., for the purchase of bonds to be issued by School District No. Sixteen, comprising the city of Pendleton and certain adjoining lands in Umatilla county, Oregon, of the par value of Sixty Thousand Dollars, bearing interest at the rate of 4 1/2 per cent per annum, payable semi-annually, principal and interest payable at the office of the county treasurer of Umatilla county, or at New York city, at the option of the purchaser. Said bonds maturing in twenty years, but being payable in ten years or after at the option of District No. Sixteen.

All bids, in order to be considered, must be accompanied by a certified check, draft or certificate of deposit, for the sum of One Thousand Dollars, to be approved by the directors of said district before said bids are opened.
