MIRACLE STATUE

WILL BE CROWNED BY ARCHBISHOP FARLEY.

Peculiar and Extremely Infrequent Observance of the Catholic Church—Function Will Take Place Out of Doors, Before Fifty Thousand Spectators—The Crown is Lapid With Precious Stones and Comes From Rome.

New York, July 9.—What is expected to be the most important and imposing religious function ever held by Italian Catholics in America will take place tomorrow, when the miraculous statue of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, in the church of that name, in East 115th street, will be solemnly crowned by Archbishop Farley.

It will be the first time such a ceremony has ever taken place in the United States. It is of rare occurrence anywhere. According to church procedure, to have a statue crowned it must possess antiquity, be the object of extraordinary devotion on the part of the people and have caused the granting of extraordinary temporal or spiritual favors. The authorities in Rome, having decided that this statue, which is renowned not only in "Little Italy," but all over the United States, possessed the necessary conditions, Archbishop Farley was especially designated to perform the ceremony.

Owing to the impossibility of getting the thousands who will want to witness the ceremony into the church it has been decided that the function shall take place in the open air in Thomas Jefferson park, a short distance from the church. The statue will be carried in procession to the park, where the archbishop, in full pontificals and surrounded by the monsignori and other dignitaries, will perform the ceremonies. The statue, escorted by the parish societies, will then be carried back to the church. It is estimated that at least 50,000 persons will be present.

The crowns for the statue, which represents the Virgin with the child Jesus in her arms, were brought from Rome, where they were made by one of the pope's jewelers. They are of solid gold, blazing with precious stones, the gifts of pious clients of the Madonna. The larger of the two is about six inches in diameter and 18 inches high. Under the cross in the front part is a large solitaire diamond. Below this is set a big emerald, surrounded by diamonds, given by the pope, and just above the circlet is a valuable emerald in a hoop of pearls, the gift of Archbishop Farley. Both crowns are lavishly ornamented with rubies, amethysts, sapphires and garnets.

Growing a Race of Sprinters.

This county seems destined to obtain a world-wide reputation as a breeding place for crackjack sprinters. The bright particular star who has lowered the colors of all competitors so far in his career is Joe Pearson, a Starbuck boy. At the coast college athletic meet at Berkeley, Cal., recently he broke the coast records in the 220 yard race, and the 440 yard race, the first he made in 22 1-5 seconds and the last in 50 3-5 seconds. At Vancouver, B. C., July 2d, Mr. Pearson carried off the first prize in the 100 yard race in 19 seconds, the 220 yard race in 22 seconds, and the 440 yard race in 50 3-5 seconds.

Another Dayton sprinter who has already won out from a strong field of competitors at the Pullman college and elsewhere is Roy Godman, son of Judge Godman of this city. At Walla Walla July 4 he won first prize in the 100 yard race, the 220 yard race and the 600 yard race, beating the best sprinters of Walla Walla.—Dayton Courier-Press.
