THE LABOR MARKET

WAREHOUSEMEN FEEL NEED OF HELP.

Sheepmen Well Supplied. But Fall Exodus of Herders Will Soon Take Place—Herders' Wages Average About \$35 Per Month With an Upward Tendency—Sheepmen Look for Montana Wages to Prevail Here Before Long.

The labor market in Pendleton offers few novelties outside of a scarcity of men to do warehouse work at \$2.50 per day and board themselves. The scarcity is because it is no snap to do the heaviest and most exacting labor at that figure and pay in some cases \$5 per week for board. Board at the warehouse points runs all the way from \$4 to \$5 per week, and at the latter points there is a proneness among observers who do not know all the conditions, to say "lots of these fellows do not want work, anyway."

The other side of it is that they will not fall over each other trying to get warehouse jobs as long as many of them can yet get employment at \$2.50 per day at hoe-down, stacking, sewing sacks, jirring sacks and tending headers, and get their board besides. Bucking sacks from the wagon, raking and loading ears, with the sacks weighing all the way from 120 to 140 pounds, takes muscle, bulk and concentration of a high order.

For general farm work supply and demand break even at \$20 per month and "found."

Sheepmen Supplied.

The demand for sheepherders is weak at this time because all the sheepmen have all the help they need, with the sheep in the mountains and a tendency to reduce the forces because of selling off many thousand sheep. Later on, when the sheep are brought in from the mountains many of the herders will either jump their jobs from very reaction from the long months of solitude with the flocks, or ask for long-time vacations which often result in the entire disappearance of the man, which will result in a demand for reliable men—this is the annual October and November program, and at that time there is a genuine demand for sheepherders.

Herders' Wages.

A large majority of the sheepherders get \$35 per month; a small proportion get \$45 per month and the tendency is toward the higher figure. This the sheepmen admit. The reasons are as follows: With the narrowing range sheepherding to the entire satisfaction of the owners is often a matter of ability to scrap with the herders of other flock owners.

It is not always easy to get herders for a rustle-range, when it is admit-

tedly increasing in risks to the men themselves, besides being more and more difficult for the herders to show sheep in good condition, making it more and more difficult to please the owners.

Wages Climb Upward.

The drift is in the direction of the Montana wage scale, which is also found in some of the Eastern Idaho districts, where more men get \$40 than get \$35, many get \$45, and some as high as \$50 per month.
