LOUISIANA DAY AT ST. LOUIS

A BRILLIANT EVENT AT THE WORLD'S FAIR.

Enthusiasm and Dignity Characterized the Occasion—Splendid Address by Governor Blanchard, Followed by Forceful and Beautiful General Exercises—Louisiana Building a Republic of the Cabildo.

St. Louis, Sept. 14.—The celebration of Louisiana day at the Louisiana Purchase exposition was carried out with an enthusiasm and dignity which reflected the historical relationship existing between the state and the event commemorated by the great fair now in progress.

Governor Blanchard, having taken a great interest in the formulation of the plans for the celebration of the day delivered an address which was a finished oratorical production and replete with suggestive historical incidents which traced the events leading up to the purchase of the Louisiana territory and the rebuilding of that section of the country in the century since its transfer.

The exercises of the day were held in the Louisiana state building, which is a replica of the Cabildo in New Orleans, in which the annual transfer of the Louisiana transfer took place in 1803. Upon arriving at the exposition grounds Governor Blanchard and his staff, with the members of the Louisiana state commission, were met and taken to the Cabildo under military escort.

NEW YORK REPUBLICANS.

G. O. P. Filled With Great Uncertainty in Empire State.

Saratoga, N. Y., Sept. 14.—For the first time in many years the republicans of New York met in state convention today with conditions approaching an open race for the gubernatorial nomination.

Governor Odell continues to declare that he has no candidate for the head of the ticket, though his partiality for Lieutenant Governor Higgins as the gubernatorial nominee is so generally recognized that it will probably result in the latter's nomination.

The convention was called to order at noon and the opening hours were taken up with the roll call, committee appointments and other perfunctory business.
