One Crop Pays for Land.  
E. K. Benninghoven, a farmer living near Coquille, is another of the many farmers of this section who has paid for a farm with a single crop. Two years ago Mr. Benninghoven came to Whitman county from Washington and bought the farm known as the Halsey place, near Dalles, for \$25 per acre. This year he got seven acres for hay and 21 tons, worth \$10 per ton. He sold the remainder of the wheat for 87 cents per bushel. This is a \$1890.40 for the crop. This is more than \$30 per acre for the three crop, hay included, which, after deducting the expenses of raising, seedling and marketing the crop, Mr. Benninghoven almost enough to pay for the land on which the crop is grown. His experience has been repeated by a number of farmers in Whitman county this year, but other farmers had larger acre-
