SEATTLE READY ******* FOR LAUNCHING

BATTLESHIP NERRASKA TO SLIP INTO THE SOUND.

Governor Mickey, of Nebraska, and Party to Arrive in Seattle Today-Miss Mickey Will Christen the Vessel-Cost of the Big Fighter Was \$3,733,000-Displacement of 14,994 Tons.

Seattle, Wash., Oct. 6 .- All az rangements have been completed at the Moran Bros.' shipyards for launching tomorrow of the hig battle-ship Nebraska. Miss Mary Nain Mickey, daughter of Gavernor Mickey of Nebraska, will break the bottle of champagne over the bows of the ves-In addition to Governor Mickey ond the other members of the party from Nebraska, the launching will be attended by many distinguished army and navy officials.

The first-class battleship Nebraska is one of five vessels of the same type and general dimensions soon to be added to the United States navy. The other four are the Virginia and the Rhode Island, which have al-ready been launched, the Georgia, which is to take to the water within the coming week, and the New Jer-805

The keel of the Nebraska was laid in July, 1902, and four months later actual construction of the vessel be-She is now about 70 per cent gan. completed and it is expected to have her ready to be turned over to the government within another year. The contract price is \$3,733,600. She will have a displacement of 14,994 tons and is designed to have a speed of 19 knots. Her main battery will consist of four 12-inch breech-loading rifles, eight S-inch breech-londing rifles and 12 6-inch rapid-fire guns. The secondary battery will consist of 12 3-inch rapid-fire guns, 12 3-pounder rapid-fire guns, eight 1-pounder rapid-fire guns, two 3-inch field guns, two machine guns and six automatic guns.
