Seward, the terminus of the new rallway, and you can say that things are rather lively up in that country. The copper country tributary to Valdez is simply marvelous.

"The Alaska Central railway, which is being built out of Seward, is now in operation 18 miles, and has about 50 men at work. It is being built by the Tanaya. Construction company. the Tanana Construction company, and is backed by the Shedds of Chicago, who are selling stock for con-

struction purposes. "The country has hardly beer scratched yet and is immensely rich in oil and copper. With a railroad in oil and copper. It now has about 1000 stamps in operation.
