FROST'S OPINION

THE RIDDLES GARFIELD'S CORPORATION CORRECTOR.

However, Frost is a Corporation Lawyer and His Opinion of an Anti-Trust Law Might Be Expected to Be a Frost-Expresses a Frantic Fear of Paternalism—Favors Unlimited Liberty for the Corporations.

New York, Jan. 6.—Thomas G. Frost, general counsel for the National Corporation Company, and author of "Frost on Incorporation," upon being interviewed in reference to the proposed federal licensing of incorporations, said:

"The proposed remedial corporation legislation recommended by Commissioner Garfield involves two separate propositions: First, the passage of a general federal incorporation law; second, the enactment of a federal statute requiring all corporations engaged in interstate commerce to procure a license from the federal government before engaging therein."

"My opinion as to the advisability and practicability of such legislation is this: A federal corporation law, permissive and not mandatory in character, while it would have much to recommend it, would do little toward remedying existing abuses. Such an act would simply meet the wants of those who preferred a charter issued under authority of the federal government, and this, too, at the expense of the state governments, who would unquestionably suffer a diminution in income were federal incorporation to be permitted. As a source of revenue to the national government, such an act would undoubtedly be a pronounced success, but as a 'trust-buster' it would be a grievous disappointment."

"The proposition to require a federal license from all state corporations engaged in interstate commerce is crude, visionary and exceedingly ill-advised from a business standpoint. It is a species of radical legislation suited to a strongly centralized government, such as France, rather than to one, such as ours, wherein the rights of the several states are carefully guarded by constitutional enactments against encroachment on their prerogatives by the federal government."

"The objections to the proposed federal license law may be briefly summarized as follows: First, it is centralization in its worst and most virulent form; second, it would be impossible to make it wholly effective owing to the fact that the right to forfeit the charters of the corporations so licensed would rest necessarily with the state authorities from whom the charter was procured. Finally, if such a bill were introduced into congress it would be difficult to find friends for it among the numerous body of 'safe and sound statesmen'."

GOVERNMENT FOREST POLICY.

Functions of Both State and Federal Laws.

Washington, Jan. 6.—The subject of national forest policy was taken up this morning by the American Forest Congress and was discussed from every point of view. The official of the general land office, geological survey and the bureau of forestry, led the discussion and outlined at great length the present work and future plans of the federal government in regard to forests and their preservation.

The congress closed its work this afternoon with a session devoted to the discussion of state forest policy. State forest officials and agents of the Bureau of Forestry, who have been extensively engaged in co-operative state forest work, treated the subject in a practical way. As a result of the discussions it is expected that uniform legislative measures looking to the protection and extension of the forests will be introduced in the legislatures of many states this winter.

SEVEN YEARS MAKING A WATCH

Contrivance Comprises an Entire Machine Shop.

Paris, Jan. 6.—A Paris firm, probably the oldest watchmakers of Europe, has just completed after seven years' work, a very remarkable watch. It is of gold and is beautifully chased.

It marks the day, month, year and leap year for 100 years; the phases of the moon, seasons, solstices, equinoxes, the time at 125 of the principal cities of the world, the rising and setting of the sun. It comprises a chronograph, a repeater for hours and minutes, a thermometer, barometer, hygrometer, altimeter up to 5000 metres, compass and a pair of small bells. It contains 24 mechanical movements, and consists of 375 distinct parts.

Asotin County News.

The board having ascertained by satisfactory evidence that the county contains a population of between 5,500 and 6000, the number required by law to entitle it to be placed in the Twentieth class, it was, by due resolution of the board, given that classification.

Bids for the completion of the forks of Asotin, known as the Cloverland road, were opened. There were two bids made, one by Caywood Bros., of \$2250, and one by F. P. Simpson for \$1950.

Cloverland is a new irrigation district situated near the headwaters of the sources of Asotin creek and the residents have very earnestly, and for some years, endeavored to have the county construct an expensive portion of road leading around a rocky point, a distance of about 7100 feet, and it was for the construction of this portion of the road that the county board called for bids.—Lewis-ton Tribune.
