Banquet at Close of Annual Central Illinois Hunt.

Bloomington, Ill., May 13.—Central Illinois farmers and hunters are rounding up for the annual crow and hawk hunt, which is conducted each May by sportsmen of Kane county. Tomorrow and Monday are the days set aside for the hunt this year, and it promises to be the biggest affair of its kind ever pulled off in this state.

Each crow killed will count for one point in the competition. Butcher birds will count three and hawks will count five points. The hunters are forming in two squads, and each will endeavor to produce the greatest number of points. The shoot will
