SURVEYORS AT WORK

NORTHERN PACIFIC ON
NORTH BANK COLUMBIA.

Engineer With Party of 30 Men Now Working on a Line Down the North Side of the River—Statement of President Elliott That Such Line Would Not Be Built May Have Been a Bluff.

Walla Walla, June 30.—Notwithstanding that President Elliott, of the Northern Pacific, has announced that the Northern Pacific railroad company is not contemplating the construction of a line down the north bank of the Columbia river, it is evident that a road is to be built along that route.

For several months a party of engineers has been at work running lines along the river and several days ago surveyors were in Kilkittat county opposite Castle Rock.

A gentleman who has a farm in the southeastern portion of Kilkittat county, in Walla Walla, yesterday stated that over 30 men were located near his place under the charge of a civil engineer. For the past two weeks they have been working up and down the river and for a great number of miles they have staked off the ground.

Last week C. E. Moulton, a former attorney for the Northern Pacific, was in Walla Walla and while here he had conferences with a number of Walla Walla people who own land in that section of the country. Some time ago these people were approached by a man representing himself as agent of a new railroad company who made an agreement with them for a right of way over their farms. The right of way deeds were made out and a small money consideration was paid by the agent.

The deeds were placed in a local bank, however, to be held in escrow until the company decided whether the right of way was desired or not. The time limit on some of the options will expire soon, and when Mr. Moulton was here last week he made an effort to get the land owners to extend the time of the options. Whether he succeeded in each case

is not known, but one of the owners refused to grant an extension. While the officials of the Northern Pacific disclaim any knowledge of the movements of the surveyors and assert that the Northern is not interested in the proposed line, a great many people who are in a position to know claim that the road is to be constructed and when completed and ready for operation that the Northern Pacific will lease it from the company that will build the road.

CATTLE KING PAYS DEBTS.

Grant G. Gillette Hunts Up Old Creditors and Squares Up.

Denver, June 30.—Grant G. Gillette, widely known as the "Cattle King," who fled from Kansas in November, 1894, after having raised money by mortgaging thousands of cattle belonging to others, but which he had in charge, came to Denver three days ago. Keeping his arrival secret, he located three Denver creditors and paid them every cent due them. Two of the Denver creditors received \$150,000. Both were caught in the crash when Gillette left Woodbine, Kan., eight years ago, and neither expected to realize a cent.

During the eight years he had been in hiding in Mexico, Gillette made a fortune. It is reported, from gold, silver, and lead mines, in the Parral district, state of Chihuahua. It is said he cleared \$7,000,000, but it is certain that he made a sum sufficient to pay all his debts.

Several weeks ago Gillette opened negotiations with his Kansas City creditors. A committee of lawyers and business men visited him in Mexico and arranged for a settlement. A week ago Gillette paid them in Kansas City. Then he came to Denver.

Gillette was 28 years of age when he fled from Kansas. At the time nearly every bank from Kansas City to San Francisco held his paper. He is now 36 years old, and came to Denver accompanied by his wife and son.

BIG IMPORT RECORD

INCREASE IN VALUES IS
TAKING PLACE RAPIDLY.

During the Last Year Nearly \$50,000,000 More Imports Have Arrived Than During the Preceding Twelve Months—Heaviest Increase Has Been in Luxuries and High-Priced Manufactures—Cigars, Sugar and Textiles Have Increased Greatly.

New York, June 30.—The government fiscal year which ended today has been a record-breaking one as regards the value of imports entering the port of New York. Although the complete figures have not yet been compiled it is known that the imports for the last 12 months exceed by nearly \$50,000,000 the entries of last year.

It is regarded as significant of the general prosperity of the country that many of the most notable increases in imports at New York are in the direction of luxuries, such as diamonds, automobiles, fine laces and similar articles.

Two of the lines showing phenomenal increases this year are sugar and precious stones, which in the aggregate are greater by \$30,000,000 than were the same imports one year ago. The entries of cigars at this port during the fiscal year have been far greater than was the case one year ago. Passengers' baggage has yielded an unusually large revenue to the treasury, as have liquors and wines. Textiles of every kind have been liberally imported, something like \$5,000,000 alone being invested in expensive St. Gall or Swiss embroideries. Many other imports have made gains with the result that the total custom house for this fiscal year approximate \$49,000,000, as compared with \$59,900,498 the previous year. All things considered, customs officials say the year has been the most prosperous so far as imports are concerned in the history of the port of New York.
