O. S. L. IS ALARMED

NEW ROAD INVADING IDAHO AND UTAH

Right of Way Secured to the Idaho Line—Chicago & Northwestern Will Parallel the Oregon Short Line Into Ogden, Where it Will Connect With the Rio Grande.

According to the Desert News of Salt Lake, the Short Line is getting anxious about the threatened invasion of its territory by the Chicago & Northwestern, and is arranging for rushing to completion of its Yellowstone park branch from St. Anthony. The News says that the Northwestern is headed for Salt Lake with a branch line running down Cache canyon, but that the main line will run to Boise and on to the coast. The News quotes from a letter received from a man in St. Anthony, who is said by the News to be an unimpeachable authority on railroad matters. The letter says in part:

Right of Way Secured.
Right of way has been secured to the Idaho line. Large tracts of coal lands have been bought up in the Jackson Hole country and land west of the Teton mountains is being secured by the agents of this road; this was all looked upon as certain indications of the Snake river valley obtaining a trunk line, but now come the assurances that these long-hoped-for improvements will materialize. The activity of the Rio Grande at Ogden in increasing its depot area and improvements had a significance that has not been hitherto fully understood.

The news is that the Chicago & Northwestern will extend through the Jackson Hole country, coming through St. Anthony via Marysville and continuing its main line southwest, touching the towns of Sugar City, Rexburg, Rigby and most probably passing somewhat to the east of Idaho Falls, thus taking in the large villages in that direction and opening up a new portion of the Snake river valley. The main object in doing this, however, is to make a more direct and quicker route to Ogden and Salt Lake City.

Into Cache Valley.
From here the road's plans are to take a little west of south course, touching Blackfoot and many of the large hamlets east of the Short Line track. From Pocatello the course lies a little east of the Short Line route, thus throwing it into Cache valley without any perceptible increase of distance, as was the case with the Short Line in former years.

From Preston the road intends paralleling the Short Line branch to Logan. Logan and Cache valley will be given special attention. From Logan there are a number of routes planned and under advisement, but the one looked upon as the most feasible at present is from Logan to Wellsville and through Wellsville and Brigham canyons and from Brigham City a little to the east of the Short Line, touching the towns of Willard, Hot Springs View, North Ogden and then into Ogden, where connection will be made with the Rio Grande and other roads.

Various Kinds of Apples.
"Pineapple" and "love apple" (tomato) are instances of the manner in which the apple has been habitually taken as the typical fruit, the name of which is naturally borrowed in christening all sorts of fruit and vegetables that only remotely resemble it. Dr. Murray's dictionary gives an imposing list of them—Jew's apple, devil's apple, kangaroo apple, and so on. A writer of the seventeenth century speaks of "the fruit or apples of palm trees," and a fourteenth century man says that "all manere aples that ben cloyed in an harde skyne, rynde, other shale, ben called Noces" quite. In the year 1000, apparently, "earth aples" meant not potatoes, but cucumbers. And even Eve's "apple" is believed to have been a citron.

Compound Interest.
A banker was urging a young man to put his money in a saving fund, where he would get compound interest on it, and in the course of his argument he used a telling fact.
"One cent," said he, "put out at compound interest at the beginning of the Christian era would amount to—How much do you suppose?"
"Oh," said the young man, "a hundred dollars or so."
"Today," said the banker, "it would amount to over \$200,000. And at simple interest what do you think it would total up?"
"About half that?"
"At simple interest it would reach only \$1.15."

Waters at the Equator.
The plentiful marine growths, both animal and vegetable, of the warm waters near the equator attach themselves to a ship's bottom in the course of a few weeks, and the ship loses both speed and dirigibility. When a British ship on the West India station was broken up a few years ago more than eighty tons of barnacles were removed from her bottom, while an American frigate of only 800 tons register had thirty cart loads of barnacles scraped from her bottom after a stay of but eight months in the warm latitudes.
