CHESTER THOMPSON TRIAL.

Many of the Thompson Family Have

Been Insane. All this forenoon the county court house rang with the eloquence of attorneys making their opening statements in the Thompson murder trial says a Tacoma dispatch. Assistant Prosecuting Attorney Miller, of King county, made a statement for the prosecution. His speech to the jury lasted half an hour and recited all the incidents leading up to the murder of Judge Emory. Miller went into minute details to prove that Thompson bought a revolver and went to Judge Emory's house for the purpose killing someone.

Judge Thompson, father of the prisoner, spoke for an hour and a half, when a recess for noon was taken He resumed at 2 p. m. The burden of his speech was that insanity is hereditary in the Thompson family. opened his talk by giving the history of his family for many generations back, relating numerous instances of inmuity among his ancestors.

After exhaustively covering this he took up the peculiarities of his son. Beginning at his babyhood he recited the mental characteristics of the boy. told of his moods, peculiarities, likes and dislikes, his irresponsibility under various conditions and his proneness to irrationalism when his emotions

His statement is of the most sweep ing character, and may last all the afternoon, all acts of Chester Thomp-son being covered and placed before jury with elaborate care. Not half of the spectators could enter the court room and the doors were locked a few minutes after the session opened this morning.
