Booher's premises, which was donated by Mr. Booher in the cause of road improvements. Mr. Lavender has a force of six men at work.

The expense of the work will be borne by the county, which is also furnishing its steam roller for this purpose. The farmers are doing the work of hauling and distributing the rock under subscription, and F. E. King, supervisor of the district south of town, has direction of the improvement. It is the intention to complete nearly two miles of road this spring, extending south from the city limits at the Bonewitz place. This is a bad stretch of road during the muddy season.

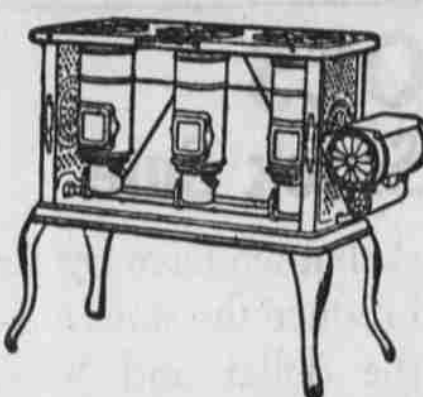
Wallowa's First Milking Machine.

Thomas Morgan says the milking machine recently installed on his Prairie creek ranch is a success, and he is well satisfied with his investment, says the Enterprise News-Record. The milker and all its accessories, engine, etc., form quite a complicated machine. No expert was sent to set it up, Mr. Morgan depending on the assistance of Mr. Hamilton of Joseph. No one who had ever seen a milker was there to teach its operation, yet when the machine was first tried it worked like a charm, and it hasn't balked once since the start. After a few days use Mr. Morgan with the assistance of his wife a part of the time, milked 28 cows in an hour and a half. When a herd becomes well broken, one person can easily attend to over 100 cows.

It is useless to attempt description of the apparatus in all its parts. It must be seen to be really understood. The suction attachments for teats and the pulsating throb of the milker, so like the natural sucking by a calf, are the chief points that has made this milker a success. Mr. Morgan says he had a letter from Dr. Withycombe, saying it was a success, and also the result of tests at the Kansas experiment station.
