FREEWATER-MILTON ECHO NEWS NOTES

MILTON NURSERY CAPITAL STOCK INCREASED.

Big Local Pay Roll This Year.—Walla Walla Lodge Visits Milton Lodge—Fruitgrowers' Union Has New Business Manager—Young People Attend Demorest Contest.

Milton, May 16.—The Milton nurseries, operated by A. Miller, S. A. Miller, G. W. Miller and C. B. Miller, have taken out articles of incorporation and are known as the Milton Nursery company, with a capital stock of \$50,000.

The officers of the new company are A. Miller, president; G. W. Miller, vice president; S. A. Miller, secretary and general manager.

The nursery was established here in 1875 by Aaron Miller, and has grown to be one of the best known in the northwest. They have recently added 40 acres making 150 acres to be devoted to the growing of nursery stock, and their shipments go to every state west of the Rocky mountains and to British Columbia, the sales aggregating \$50,000 per year. The local pay roll during the coming year will amount to \$12,000.

MAY MAKE NEW STATES OUT OF OLD

Washington, May 16.—With Oklahoma now quite at home in the family of states and New Mexico and Arizona knocking for admission, it would appear that the limit of the number of commonwealths in the Union would soon be reached. Already, however, there is much discussion among congressmen of making new states out of old ones, and some of these projects are being taken seriously. For years, at occasional intervals, it has been proposed that the unwieldy bulk of Texas should be divided into at least two, and possibly four states. This proposition has never met with the favor of the republican leaders in congress, owing to political reasons, and it is more than likely that the Lone Star state will maintain its integrity for many years to come.

Less opposition has been provoked by the proposal to form a new state of what is known as the inland empire, comprising portions of the states of Washington, Idaho and Oregon, with Spokane as the capital. It has been suggested that the new commonwealth thus organized be christened Lincoln, thus bringing sentimental as well as commercial reasons to the support of the scheme. It is urged that the interests of the inland empire are directly opposed to the balance of the states of which it forms a part and that the formation of the new state would be of direct advantage to all concerned.

Another project which has come to the front in the last few weeks is the forming of a new state of the northern parts of Michigan, Minnesota and Wisconsin, with Duluth as the probable capital. This section forms the mineral districts of the three states, bordering on the lakes, with interests entirely different from the agricultural sections.

In order to bring about the formation of such new states, there would have to be favorable action by the legislatures of all the states affected and by the congress of the United States. It would be a slow and difficult process, and it is unlikely that the number of states will be increased by this method for many years to come.

SHEEP SHEARING COMPLETED IN ECHO COUNTRY.

Thousands of Head Sheared in This Vicinity—Man Arrives From Michigan to Go in Drug Business—Fourth of July Celebration Planned for Echo—Purchase Lands.

Echo, May 16.—The sheep shearing plant which has been in operation for some weeks in this vicinity, and which is owned by a number of the prominent Umatilla county sheepmen, has been shut down for the season, and the crew has gone to Heppner.

During the few weeks the plant was in operation there were 64,156 sheep sheared at the Slusher ranch and the White house, the amount being distributed as follows: T. D. Mathews, 1530; M. S. Corrigan, 3530; Joe Cunha, 7772; Antone Vey, 5892; R. N. Standfield, 15,900; Cunningham Sheep & Land company, 9802; Pat Doherty, 2476; Paul Sperry, 1881, and William Slusher, 12,163.
