## PYTHIAN SISTERS ALSO COMING

### TWO GRAND LODGE SESSIONS AT SAME TIME

Pendleton Will Be Called Upon to Entertain Large Fraternal Gathering in June of Next Year—Two Pendleton Men Honored at Recent Meeting in Portland.

In addition to the Knights of Pythian grand lodge which will convene in this city next June, the grand temple, Pythian Sisters, will also meet here at that time and the throng that will be here for the K. of P. meeting will be increased by 100 or more ladies who will be attending the grand session of the auxiliary order.

Aside from those attending the grand lodge sessions several of the subordinate lodges of the state will have teams here for third rank competitive work similar to that in which Pendleton Knights have successfully competed in the past. A \$100 trophy is offered by the grand lodge to the winning team.

The selection of Pendleton as the meeting place for next year was a signal honor for this city for it has been the custom to meet in Portland for several years past and no other town outside of the metropolis could have secured the session for next year. Portland members themselves aided the Pendleton delegation in getting the meeting for next year and their unselfishness was highly appreciated.

Outside members of the order also strongly praise the manner in which the grand lodge people were entertained in Portland this year. The principal social feature was an elaborate banquet given Wednesday night in the splendid new quarters of the Portland commercial club. The affair was under the auspices of the Knights of Khorassan, the fun-making auxiliary, and Judge Bradshaw of The Dalles, was toastmaster.

Gus Moser, the well known Portland attorney, was elected as grand chancellor of the order for the coming year and he presided during the recent session. Frank Menefee of The Dalles was chosen grand vice chancellor and J. W. Maloney, cashier of the Savings bank, was reelected as grand master of exchequer.

Present plans are to make the coming year the most active in the history of Oregon Pythianism and Grand Chancellor Moser is intending to visit every portion of the state during his term. A monster mid-winter district convention is planned to be held in Pendleton during the year and it will be for all the lodges of eastern Oregon and eastern Washington. E. B. Aldrich was named as district deputy grand chancellor for Umatilla county for the coming year.

arraignment which has been set for Monday morning next at 10 o'clock, says the Oregon Daily Journal.

Colonel Raley did not care to discuss the indictment which has been returned against him by the federal grand jury or to make any statement of his side of the case at this time.

"I have not seen a copy of the indictment and do not know except from newspaper accounts what the charges are," said Colonel Raley this morning. "I do not care to make any statement at this time, therefore, and will not until I have had time to familiarize myself with the facts. When I have done so, however, I will be glad to give my side of the controversy."

Colonel Raley will remain in Portland until the middle of next week, and will be present in the federal court on Monday next when all those indicted for connection with the Umatilla cases will be present and ready for arraignment.

Can It Be Possible?

During the past year a vacuum bottle has been put on the market which will keep contents hot for 24 hours, warm for 48 hours and cold for 72 hours. The bottle consists of two glass bottles, joined at the neck, one bottle being within the other, a vacuum space between the two bottles prevents outside temperature from reaching the inner one, thus permitting contents to remain hot or cold (the same temperature as when placed in the bottle) for days at a time.
