

Attorneys for Murderer Think They Won't Be Given Fair Deal.

Change of venue to some other county than Walla Walla is asked in petition filed in superior court today by E. C. Mills, E. F. Barker and Oscar Cain, attorneys for Bud Barnes. They claim that Barns would be unable to get a fair trial in this county, owing to the prejudice against him in the minds of the people, obtained by reading the papers and in discussion and attendance at the trial.

Answer to the petition, together with affidavits will be filed by Attorney Rupp for the state, late this afternoon or tomorow morning and the petition will be argued tomorrow

In an affidavit Attorney Cain sets forth that he defended Barnes at his last trial that since the trial he and his associate Frank Garrecht have been criticized for defending Barnes, the jury has been condemned, and people have had a very hostile attitude toward Bud Barnes. Further, he swears that he has frequently heard on the streets that Barnes "should be hanged and that the same treatment should be accorded the jurors who sat on the trial."

Affidavits setting forth that the public is against a fair trial in Walla Walla county are also filed by A. H. Harris and Rev. Andreas Bard.
