ECLIPSE OF SUN VISIBLE SUNDAY

PARTIALLY DARKENED
FOR PENDLETON PEOPLE.

Moon Will Come Between Earth and Old Sol Tomorrow Morning Between the Hours of 7 and 9—People With Smoked Glasses Will Have Chance to Witness Rare Sight.

Washington, June 27.—Old Sol will go into partial eclipse tomorrow morning and for over three hours will hide his face from the people of a considerable portion of the United States. The area in which the eclipse may be observed covers the North American continent south of latitude 60, as well as South America north of the equator and large portions of the Atlantic and Pacific oceans, southwestern Europe and west Africa. As the moon is now at almost its greatest distance from the earth, it will not, when apparently directly in front of the sun, quite conceal it. The area where such a central observation may be made and where the eclipse is most nearly total is about 200 miles wide and extends across Mexico, the Gulf and Florida.

The first contact of the eclipse, as viewed in Washington, will begin at 9:27 tomorrow morning, reaching its greatest degree of obscuration at 11:22 and ending at 12:59 o'clock. At its height, shortly after 11 o'clock, about three-fourths of the sun's rays will be cut off and the greater part of the United States will pass into semi-obscure.

As observed in Washington, the moon will appear to pass before the southern part of the sun, beginning at the right edge and gradually covering all the lower part of the disc. At its height the eclipse will transform the sun into a crescent of a width about a third the diameter of the sun. At this time, the shape of the sun can readily be perceived by gazing at it through smoked glass.

Little significance is attached to a partial eclipse of the sun by astronomers, as all possible observations under such conditions have already been made. Only a total eclipse now has a scientific interest, since it affords opportunities for studying the sun's surroundings not possible at any other time.

Tomorrow's eclipse will begin at 6:12 in San Francisco, at 7:21 in Denver at 8:03 in New Orleans, at 8:41 in Chicago, at 8:38 in Tampa, at 9:38 in New York, at 10:08 in Boston and at corresponding differences of time in intermediate cities.
