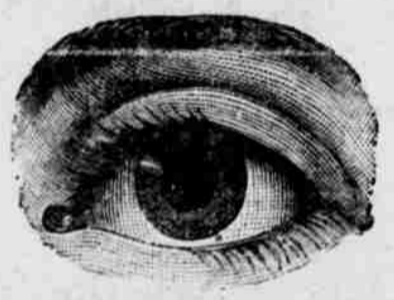

On examination Sunday by Dr. Sharp it was found that one rib was broken, another fractured and several other injuries sustained on his body. It is thought that none of the injuries are serious. A suit will be brought against the Indian for damages.
