

Indian Hash.

Chop sufficient cold roasted turkey. duck or chicken to make a pint. Cut a good sized onion into very thin Pare, core and chop fine one slices. apple. Put two tablespoons of buttler a saucepan, add the apple and onion; toast until brown, then add not more than one-eighth of a teaspoon of powdered mace, a half teaspoonful of salt, a teaspoon of curry powder, a tablespoonful of flour, a teaspoon of sugar; mix and add half a pint of stock or water; now add the meat; stir constantly until smoking hot, then tand over hot water; covering closely for twenty minutes. Add two tablespoons of lemon juice and serve in a border of boiled, well-seasoned rice.

Scald one pint of milk; dissolve in t one scant teaspoonful of salt and two tablespoonfuls of butter, and pour into a bowl. When lukewarm add one. half yeast cake dissolved in two tablespoonfuls of warm water and sufficient sifted flour to make a thin drop batter. Beat hard for five minutes, set the bowl in a pan of hot water, cover with a cloth and set aside in a warm place to rise.
