PACIFIC COAST IS LAND OF PROMISE

PROF. ZUEBLIN DELIVERS LECTURE ON DYNAMIC WEST

Says Future Developments of West Will Far Surpass Most Fabulous Dreams of Most Enthusiastic Spirit of West is Youth, He Says, and Predicts Mississippi Valley Will Be Seat of Power That Rules the World.

New York.—Professor Charles Zueblin, formerly of the University of Chicago, predicted a wonderful future for the "Golden West" at a lecture at the Waldorf-Astoria. The lecture was the first of a series on the "Dynamic West," given under the auspices of the Women's Welfare department of the National Civic federation. Among those present were Miss Anne Morgan, Ida Tarbell and Miss Elizabeth Marbury. Professor Zueblin said the future developments of the west would far surpass the "most fabulous dreams of the most enthusiastic." He said that the Pacific coast would be a paradise, and that the Mississippi valley would some day be the seat of power of the world. Incidentally he gave a rap at the old time conventions, and stated that the progress of America lay in the spirit of the west, which was the spirit of youth.

Great Power in West. "The spirit of spontaneity of the west will sooner or later place that section of country far in advance of the east," said Professor Zueblin. "One explanation of the progress that is going on along the Pacific coast is youth. We are old, the west is young."

When the Pacific coast comes into its own the Mississippi valley will be the seat of power of the world. The administration will remain in the east, but the power will come from the west.

MYSTERY OF THE FLY.

London Scientist Says Common House Pests Have Poor Eyesight. London.—Henry Hill has delivered at the London Institution a fascinating lecture on the life and habits of the house fly.

For seven or eight years past Mr. Hill has had this insect under close observation. "I have given a great deal of time to the question of the fly's ability to see," he said.

"My own belief is that the house fly has no acuteness of vision. I have put a spider and fly together in a glass and seen the latter jump on the spider's back. Again, I have seen a fly proceed to one-eighth of an inch distance from a motionless spider. The fact that the fly in the latter distance had been perfectly safe suggests that the spider also has an acuteness of vision."

Mr. Hill asserted, with reference to the insect's homely name of "house" fly, that if it were called, as it might truthfully be called, the "cholera" fly or the "typhoid" fly, we should be far less tolerant of it. He stated that the

flies we see in the house at this time of the year are center-hatched insects and not survivors from the summer warmth.

"I wish I could explain why a fly never walks down but always up a clean window pane, and why, on the other hand, it will walk down the slanting glass front of a picture. These are habits of the house fly which offer a field for interesting study."

ABRUZZI GOING TO VENICE.

Duke to Take Command of Great Arsenal After Year's Wait.

Rome.—The Duke of the Abruzzi is to have command of the great arsenal at Venice, where he will reside in a wing of the royal palace facing the Piazzetta and the Doge's Palace.

The Duke was appointed to this command nearly a year ago, but since then the Katharine Elkins incident and his subsequent journey to the Himalayas prevented him taking up the post.

It is rumored at Venice that a "Dreadnought" battleship will be laid down as soon as the royal command starts business there. The Marquis Durazzo, the Duke's flag captain, who accompanied him on his Arctic and Himalayan expeditions, will be with him at Venice as his chief aid.

SCULPTORS TO COMPETE.

Swiss Monument to Commemorate the Telegraph Union.

Geneva.—The Swiss Federal Council has recently issued the program of a competition for the erection of a monument at Berne to commemorate the foundation of the International Telegraph Union. The competition is open to all artists in the world, and will be decided by an international jury.

The cost of the monument must not exceed \$25,000, in addition to carriage expenses, customs duties and the

cost of the foundation up to the ground level. The jury will distribute \$4,000 among deserving competitors. Models must be deposited at the Federal Palace, Berne, before August 15, 1910.

Japan Looks for War.

Berlin.—The St. Petersburg correspondent of the Vossische Zeitung states that M. Glesner, a member of the council of the empire, who recently returned from a journey through China and Japan has presented a report, according to which he ascertained that Japan was preparing to face the possibility of war with Rus-

sia next year, and would probably then declare it. M. Glesner asserts that the situation of Russia in Central Asia is an unenviable one, and advises the Russian diplomats to conciliate the Chinese. He expresses the opinion that in case of war Japan, falling the help of England, would be likely to find allies in Germany and Austria.
