### PLANS FOR HUGE BORE UNDER COUNCIL CREST PROVIDE FOR AUTOMOBILE DRIVEWAY



One million dollars will be spent by the Ogden men behind the project to tunnel under Council Crest and establish a suburban residence district in the Tualatin valley east of the big hill.

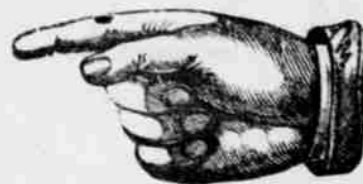
Plans for this project have so far progressed that the promoters have procured options on practically two thirds of the Tualatin valley contiguous to the eastern foot of Council

Crest, and in part along the eastern slope of the hill. The route for the tunnel has also been determined upon, and permission gained to construct the bore according to this route.

It is intended to make this tunnel of sufficient size to permit an automobile or carriage driveway on either side of the car track, which is to be laid in the middle. The tunnel will be a little over a mile in length, and will give

a means of maintaining a 7-minute car service between the downtown district of the city and the heart of the Tualatin valley, thus opening that district as one of the most desirable and beautiful residence sections of the city.

The plans of the capitalists back of the project are now in course of organization, and it is expected that the first steps toward actual construction will begin before the summer is over.
