DRY WEATHER BRINGS WHEAT MARKET UP

Chicago, June 20.—Wheat advanced 2c to 3 1/8c a bushel today on reports of lack of rain in the fields.

There was a weaker feeling abroad. Liverpool opened 5-8d lower and closed with a loss of 1-4d.

A special from St. Paul says that the Pioneer Press reports that no serious damage had been inflicted upon the wheat crop yet but all reports are insistent that rains are badly needed.

American grain visible supply: Wheat—Decreased 1,577,000 bushels. Corn—Decreased 552,000 bushels. Oats—Decreased 605,000 bushels.

European export stocks: Wheat—4,376,000 bushels; increased 372,000 bushels.

Corn—1,384,000 bushels; decreased 111,000 bushels.

A special from Milwaukee says that the oats crop there is looking very bad.

CHURCH GROWTH IN U. S. ON INCREASE

Washington.—Church growth in the United States has been greater than the increase in population between the years 1900 and 1906, according to the special census report on the census of religious bodies for 1906, now in press.

London.—Two members of the diplomatic corps who have loomed large in London society for a number of years are soon to be transferred to other scenes of usefulness.

It has long been an open secret that both the Marquis de Soveral, Portuguese ambassador in this country, and Count Mensdorff-Pouilly, the head of the Austrian embassy, have been retained here for so many years merely because the late King Edward desired their presence.

When King Manuel of Portugal ascended the throne of his murdered father, it was generally understood that the presence of Marquis de Soveral was earnestly desired in Lisbon by the queen mother, but the late king intervened and procured for his retention in his country, and in the end Queen Amelia acceded to his request.

"Blue Monkey" as the marquis is generally known in his circle, was one of the most intimate friends of the late King
