

SHEEP ARE EASY BUT LAMBS HOLD FIRMLY

FEW ARRIVALS IN YARDS WITH EXCEPTION OF SHEEP Trading Is Slow—Good Demand for Lambs—Few Hogs Arrive—Cattle Market Not Overfirm.

Portland Union Stockyards, July 15.—Sheep market showed a tinge of weakness today and trading was slow. There continues a very good demand for lambs and values rule intact at a range of \$5.75 to \$6.

Cattle market, while showing no arrivals this morning, is not overfirm although the tone is steady. The trade seems to be very well supplied with cattle.

Hogs are holding fairly steady although there is an inclination among the larger buyers to follow the downward trend of affairs in the east and middle west.
