There are today both radical and conservative wings in both parties—and their differences are irreconcilable. There is vastly more difference within the parties than there is between them.

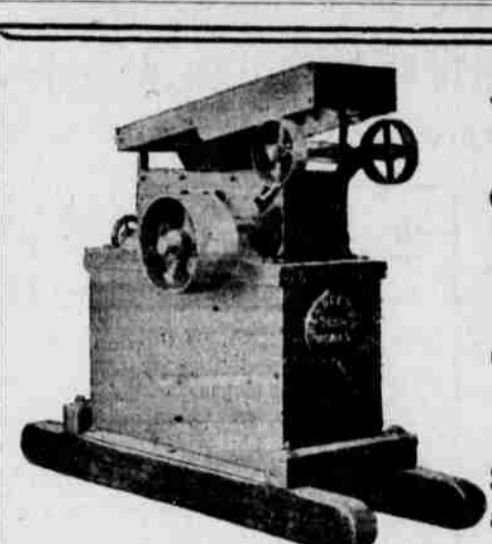
