

Berlin .--- Final details for the new course of instruction in rifle shooting to be given in the Austrian grade schools have now been perfected by the ministry for national defense. The cheme goes beyond the mere teaching of the use of the rifle and will include general outlines of army organization, the study of maps, and selected portions of military history. 


