Eastern Oregon has a great friend on the Supreme Bench Justice Will R. King, who is a candidate for reelection and whose place George H. Burneth, nominee of the Republican ssembly, is trying to secure. Judge King is a candidate on he Non-Political Judiciary movement, together with Judgee Slater, McBride and Moore. The Non-Political Judiciary movement was started by the Oregon Bar Association and has its object the removal of the Supreme Court beyond the each of political influences. In addition, Judges King, Slater, Moore and McBride have the vast amount of work before the Supreme Court well in hand and the organization of the Supreme Court well perfected.

Judge King, whose cut appears above, has made an enviable record on the supreme bench. He was the author of the opited opinion in case of Hough vs. Porter, which is now used over the West as authority on irrigation law and is used as textbook in some Eastern law schools. Three months work equired in examining the law and evidence in writing this one
pinion. Other notable opinions by Judge King, which have commanded the admiration of the people and the bar alike, re Straw vs. Harris ( 54 Ore., 424), upholding and clarifying the initiative and referendum system of law making and Hough Porter ( 51 Or., 318) which has become a leading case on irrigation law. He has turned out many other heavy decisions, et the total number of opinions he has rendered is as great as hat of any Supreme Judge in many years, the false report of the Oregonian notwithstanding.

Judge King has the support of practically all Oregon lawyers, who have manifested great approval of the thoroughneess of his research work in the Supreme Court. He was nominated not only by the Non-Political Judiciary convention but also by his name on the primary ballot
