LIQUOR TAX HITS HEAVILY.

Increase of Price Results in Less Drinking in Ireland.

Dublin.—Another searching light is cast on the working of England's famous budget in Ireland by the appearance of some clinching statistics issued by the official customs and excise commissioners. These figures place the conservative prophecy that Lloyd-George would lose money by raising liquor taxes in Ireland on the firm ground of assured fact.

Despite the fact that whiskey costs 2 cents more a glass this year than last, the government has collected in

spirit duties over \$15,000,000 less than when liquor was lower.

Thus, instead of making anything on the tax, the liberals are confronted with a big loss of revenue. It is evident that a "limit of taxation" has been reached, and further increase only drives down consumption.

It has also driven down actual production, for the report shows that the amount of whiskey distilled in Ireland has fallen off 12 per cent. The recent semi-annual meetings of stockholders in the various whiskey firms all faced big drops in dividends, so there appears to be a general loss all around. But the liberals stoutly maintain that the effective boom to temperance is not to be ignored.

For a decreased consumption of whiskey, while it may cut in on the frequently cited "widows and orphans" who have their money in whiskey distilleries, registers mechanically, nevertheless, on the credit side of the nation's balance sheet. Apart from the improved moral stamina therefrom derived, there are statistics of decrease in crime, petty disorder and drunkenness, a big drop in infant mortality rates and a general uplift of the standard of national health all around. To all these results the decreased consumption of whiskey counts inevitably as a contributing cause, and any tampering with the liquor taxes will be opposed by hardy arguments based on these achievements.
