## BUDDHISM MAKES ADVANCE IN EUROPE

The past year was a record breaker for the advance of Buddhism in Europe. The membership of the Buddhist Society of Great Britain and Ireland is now counted by hundreds and branches have been established in Liverpool and Edinburgh. A Scottish convert to Buddhism who is now a monk in Burma is shortly coming to England as first resident missionary. Great progress has also been made by the German Buddhist society, which has two important press organs in Leipzig and Breslau. In Switzerland and Italy the number of adherents of the ancient oriental faith is growing steadily, but the movement has not been entirely successful in Hungary

## owing to the opposition of the Roman Catholics.

## HOLLAND ENGAGED IN DEFENSE DEBATE

The projected fortifications of Holland at the mouths of the river Scheldt, still form the subject of animated debate in the Dutch press and also in the Belgian papers, which ex-

press a fear that the Flushing fortifications would isolate Antwerp in case of war. The resignation of General Cool, war minister for the Netherlands, is regarded as an indication that the Dutch government will withdraw the fortification bill, which has proved unpopular in and out of Holland.
