

NOTICE OF PROPOSED CHARTER AMENDMENT.

The Common Council has ordered a special election to be held May 9, 1911 to vote on measures proposed by Initiative Petition filed with the City Recorder and transmitted to the Common Council, as follows:

The bonds issued pursuant to this section shall be known as Water Bonds, Series C, shall have those words written, printed, lithographed or engraved thereon, such bonds shall be numbered consecutively, commencing with No. 1 and if the whole amount of bonds authorized by this section shall not be issued at the same time, any subsequent issue shall be numbered con-

secuting with the number next following the last number used in the next preceding issue of such bonds.

The term "Improve" and "Improvement," as used in this Act in reference to streets, shall be construed to include all grading or regrading, paving or repaving, macadamizing or remacadamizing, graveling or regaveling, and all manner of bridge-work and roadway improvement or repair, and all manner of constructing sidewalks, crosswalks, sewers, gutters and curbs within any of the streets in The City of Pendleton, or any part of any such street, and such improvements may be made in the following manner: (1) The Council, whenever it may deem it expedient, is hereby authorized and empowered to order the whole or any part of the streets of the city to be improved, to determine the character, kind and extent of such improvement, to levy and collect an assessment upon all lots and parcels of land specially benefited by such improvement, to defray the whole or any portion of the cost and expense thereof, and to determine what lands are specially benefited by such improvement and the amount to which each parcel or tract of land is benefited. (2) Whenever the Council shall deem it expedient or necessary to improve any street or streets or any part or parts thereof, within The City of Pendleton, it shall require from the City Surveyor plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement and estimates of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, together with a statement of the lots, parts of lots and parcels of land to be benefited by such proposed improvement, and the percentage of the total cost of improvement which each of such lots, parts of lots
