Athena, Ore., May 1.—Fortune being in their favor was all that saved a party of four people of this city a very serious runaway accident with a team yesterday. B. B. Richards and wife and H. H. Hill and wife had just started to Weston in a surrey yesterday afternoon and had only gotten a short distance from town when the team became frightened at a road grader standing in the road and ran upon a bank, tipping the rig over and partially throwing the occupants out. Mr. Richards who was driving, happened to light on his feet and thus held the team from running, for if they had run they would have dragged the two women to death as they were held in by the top of the surrey. The other gentleman, Mr. Hill, was thrown clear out and was unhurt but in turning over the rig ploughed the left leg of Mrs. Hill and severely bruised the ankle and knee. Outside of her injuries there was no other than slight bruises to the other parties. The team was owned by Harry McBride of this city.
