#### PLEASURE RESORT HORROR.

Wharf Collapses and Hundreds Fall With Debris,

Montreal.-Through the collapse of wharf at King Edward's park, a pleasure resort on Isle Gros Bois, 12 miles from here, between 50 and 60 persons were injured. The collapse occurred when the wharf was packed with hundreds of pleasure seekers awaiting a ferryboat to convey them to Montreal. The crowd tried frantically to retreat, but its members were so closely massed that escape was impossible, and hundreds plung-ed down in the midst of shattered beams and planks. So far no death has been reported and it is believed nobody was fatally injured. Broken limbs seemed to be the most serious hurts sustained.
