(Special Correspondence,) Hermiston, Ore., Sept. 13 .- Few people take time to investigate official crop records of Oregon, and the Northwest, and especially to compare them with what is being done in this section of the country and on the Umatilla project. Farmers have aly experimented with timothy, Alfalfa is grown here in large quanites, and of extra good quality, nearevery farmer having a small acrege, while some have devoted their entire acreage to its culture. The average yield in the state is 3.117 tons. Here the yield averaged 7 tons and at the price given the average profit per acre is \$61.11, or a little more than double the average for the tate.

On potatoes the comparison is even greater. The average for the state is \$46.87. Here on the project figures btained from farmers place the returns at an average of \$140 per acre This shows profits three times greatthan the state average.

One might go right down the list and take averything grown on the profect and compare it with the average ield of the state, and in every intance a good substantial increase could be shown over the figures from official crop records. 
