

ANOTHER STEER SOLD FOR FANCY FIGURE

ANIMAL PREPARED FOR XMAS BRINGS \$10 PER 100

Recent Sales Demonstrate Possibilities of Market for Extra High Grade Beef—Receipts at Portland Are Light—Wheat Drops.

From Wednesday's Journal. The feature at the yards in North Portland this morning was the sale of a Christmas steer weighing 2100 pounds for \$10 a hundred. The steer was sold by A. G. Dun of Wapato, It was a thoroughbred Durham. The transaction goes to show that there is a market for high grade stock and should set a pace for stockmen.

Receipts at the yards were light today, as compared with yesterday. The bulk of transactions was in hogs about 200 head being sold. Prices ranged from \$4.26 to \$6.35.

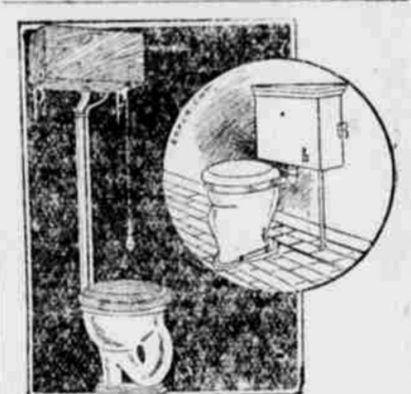

Chicago, Dec. 21.—In spite of the higher and stronger cables yesterday morning, the local wheat market was somewhat heavier, from 1-8 to 3-8 for wheat futures. The cash prices were unchanged to a fraction lower. The weak Liverpool market held the wheat market in check, as the primary receipts showed a falling off as against those of a year ago. There was a moderate amount of trade during the session, however, in the face of lower foreign markets.
