(From Wednesday's Journal.) There was a slightly weaker feeling in the cattle trade for the day at North Portland. Stock that would have brought \$7.25 quite readily at the start of the week or last week, sold a dime lower at \$7.15 with both local and Puget sound interests buyers at this figure. Several loads went at the high mark.

Finally the assemblage agreed upon despatching a request to the King of Italy asking him to petition the French government to repeal the decree. Should the French government be disinclined to listen, the flower growers of Liguria intend taking further action.
