**Delicious Maple Sugar Cake.**  
The maple sugar season having arrived, many will be glad to learn about the confections of which this delicious sweet is a part. For maple

cake, take one cup granulated sugar, yolks of two eggs, one rounding teaspoonful of butter; cream together. Add one half teaspoonful of soda dissolved in three quarters of a cup of

water. Stir well, then add one and one half cup of flour and one teaspoonful of cream of tartar. Beat well and bake in three layers. Maple sugar frosting: One and one half cups of maple syrup; boil in a saucepan until it spins a thread. Take from fire and slowly add the beaten white of one egg. Stir until thick and cold. Put between the layers and on top.

To make maple gingerbread, take one cupful of boiling water, add two tablespoonfuls of butter and one cup-

ful of maple syrup. Sift two cupfuls of flour with one half teaspoonful of ginger, one half teaspoonful of salt and three teaspoonfuls of baking powder. Beat into the maple mixture. Add one beaten egg and bake forty minutes in a medium hot oven.

For maple spice drops, to one cupful of maple syrup add the well beaten yolks of three eggs, one half cupful of butter, one half cupful of milk, one-fourth teaspoonful each of ground nutmeg, cloves and cinnamon. Add three tablespoonfuls of baking powder and one-half teaspoonful of salt sifted with flour enough to make a dough stiff enough to drop in small spoonfuls on buttered tin. Bake in a quick oven.

In melting maple sugar to make maple syrup, the addition of one part of granulated sugar to three parts of maple sugar will be found an economy, and one can scarcely distinguish

#### Cleaning Carpet.

If the carpets are only stained in spots, having grease spilled on them, sweep thoroughly, then sprinkle potash' clay very thickly over the grease spots, cover with a soft brown paper and set a quite warm flatiron on the paper over the spot; repeat until all the grease is drawn out, says the Commoner. If the carpet requires cleaning all over, take up, shake the dust out of it, spread on a clean floor and rub over the breadths—a small space at a time—raw, grated potatoes, using a new broom to rub the pulp on them. Let the carpet dry before using it.

#### The Square Tucked Train.

A new train is cut with a wide square end and the end gathered into rather broad tucks. The tucks were close together, and instead of being ironed down flat they were slightly pressed the reverse way, so that they gave the fluted appearance that was very attractive.

#### Keeps Cake Fresh.

Keep cake in a pail or large glass jar with a glass stopper, and it will remain fresh and moist for a week. An eight or ten-pound lard bucket with a tight-fitting lid, serves well for this purpose.
